Submission guidelines:

Undergraduates are encouraged to submit philosophy papers on any topic. Submissions may be no longer than **4000 words** and must be emailed to <u>undergradphiloonference@unc.edu</u> by **December 17, 2012**.

Submissions should be prepared for blind review but should include a cover sheet with the following information:

- 1. Full name
- 2. Name of university
- 3. Email address
- 4. The paper's title
- 5. Abstract (150 words maximum)
- 6. Word count of submission

Email a copy of your paper as an attachment in Microsoft Word or Rich Text Format to <u>undergradphilconference@unc.edu</u>. Title your document according to this schema:

Authors who cannot be contacted via email will be rejected. Some travel funding may be available for accepted authors whose own University is unable to assist.
