* Man vs. Person

What is the soul?

- The soul, in essence, is consciousness.
 - Metacognition
 - Perceptions

* What is consciousness?

 One of Locke's major idea's about consciousness is that identity is based off of memory.

Memory is just consciousness extended backwards
