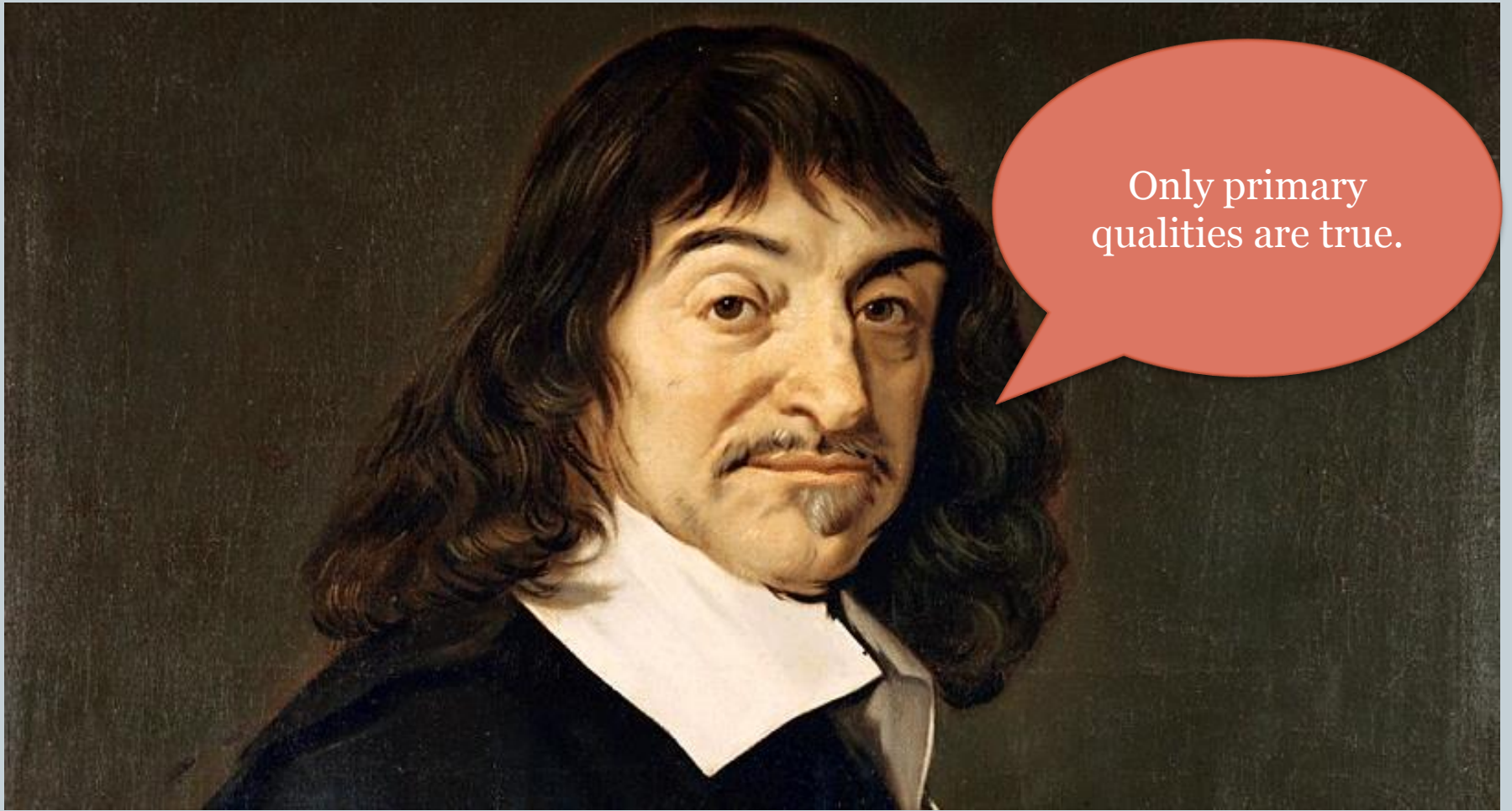

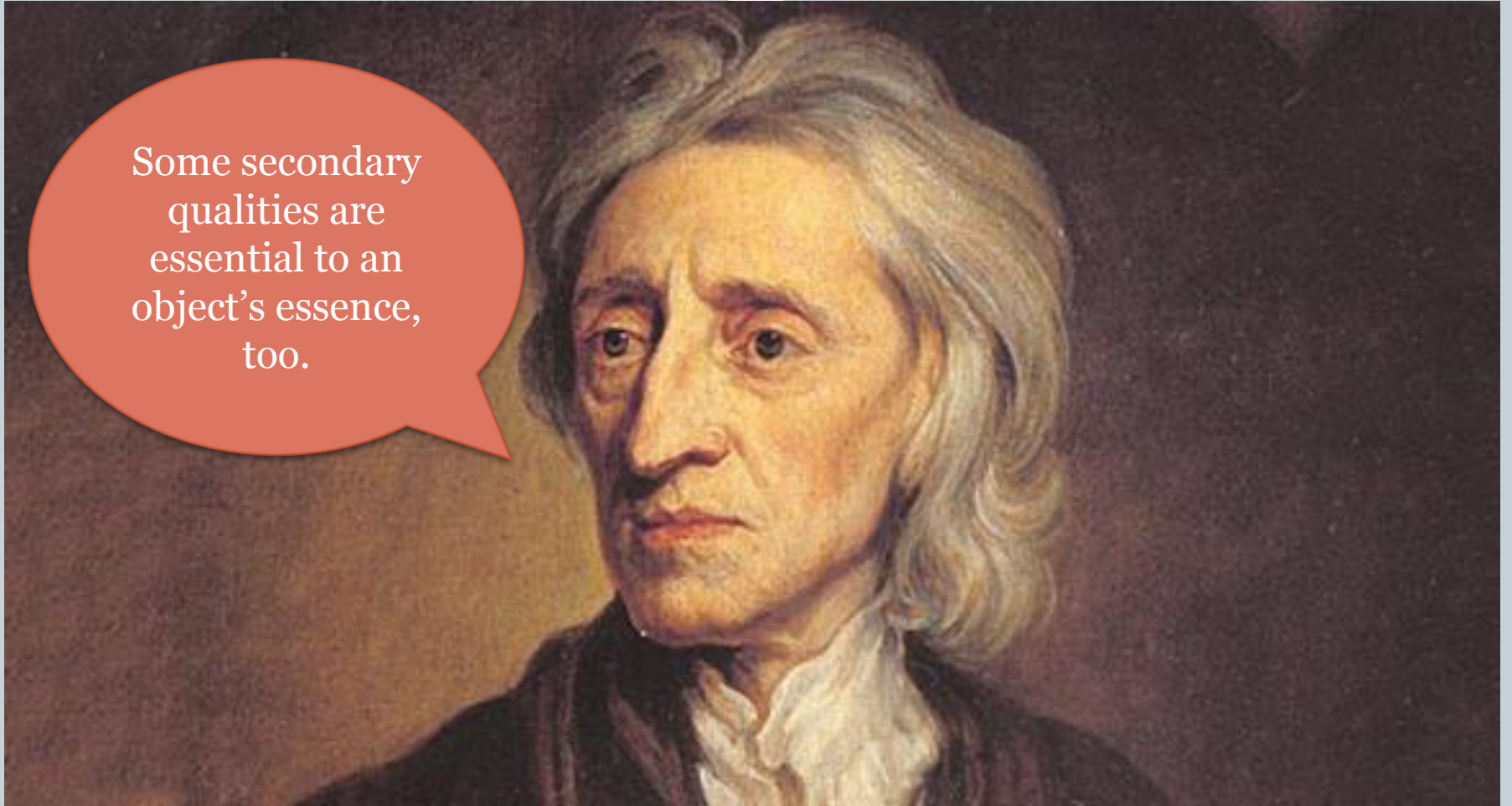


Only primary

too.

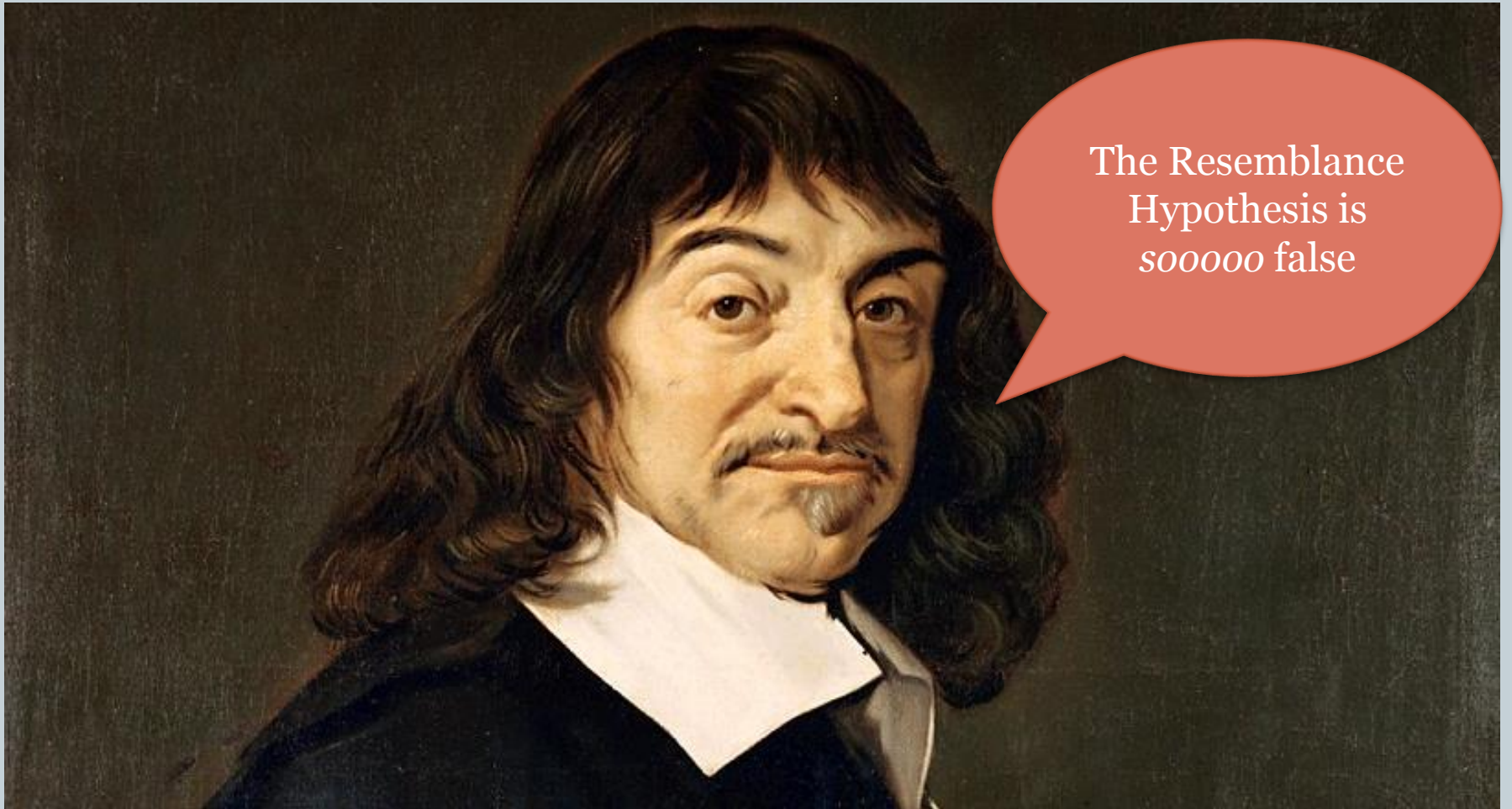


George Berkeley

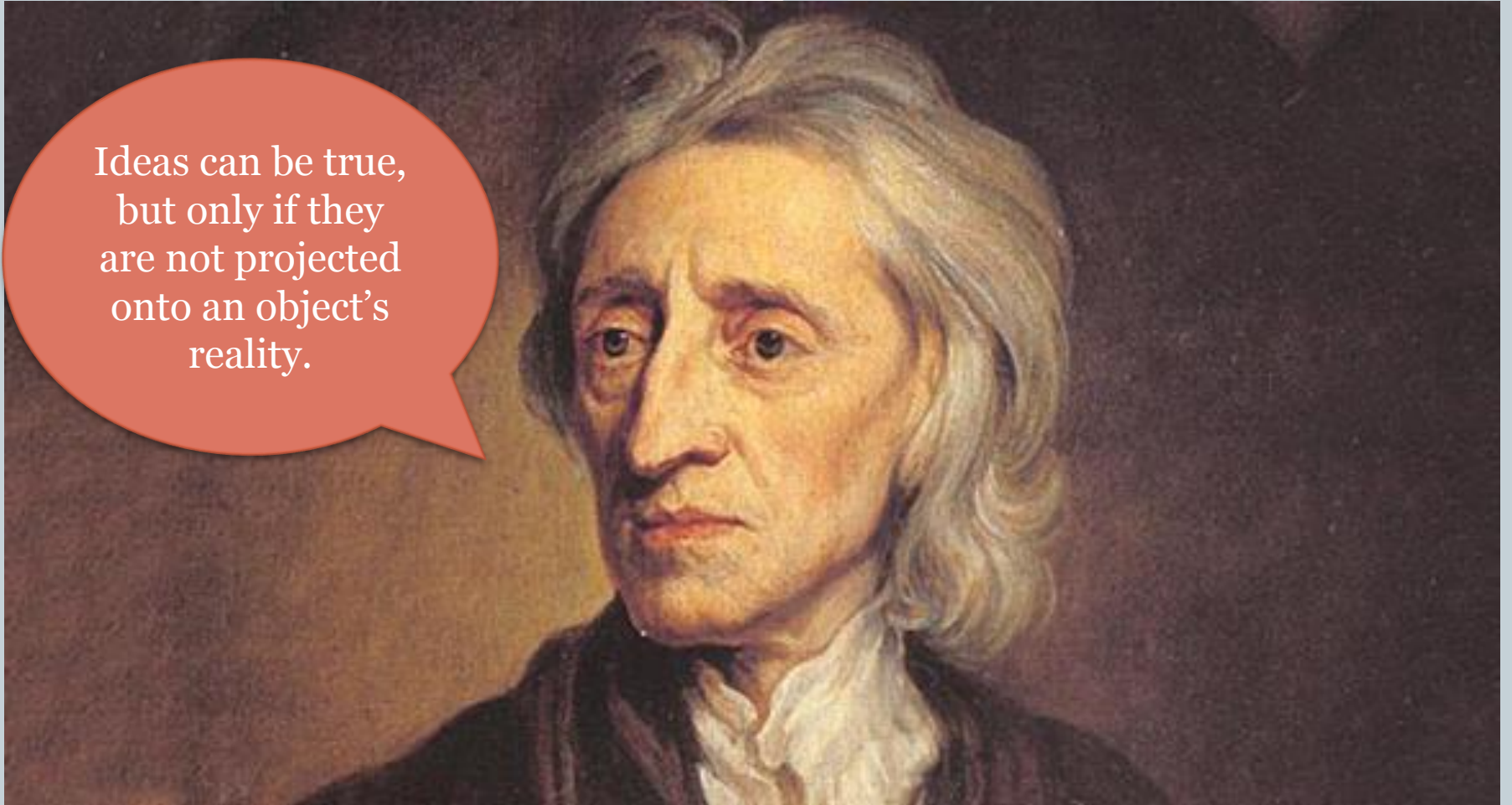


The Resemblance
